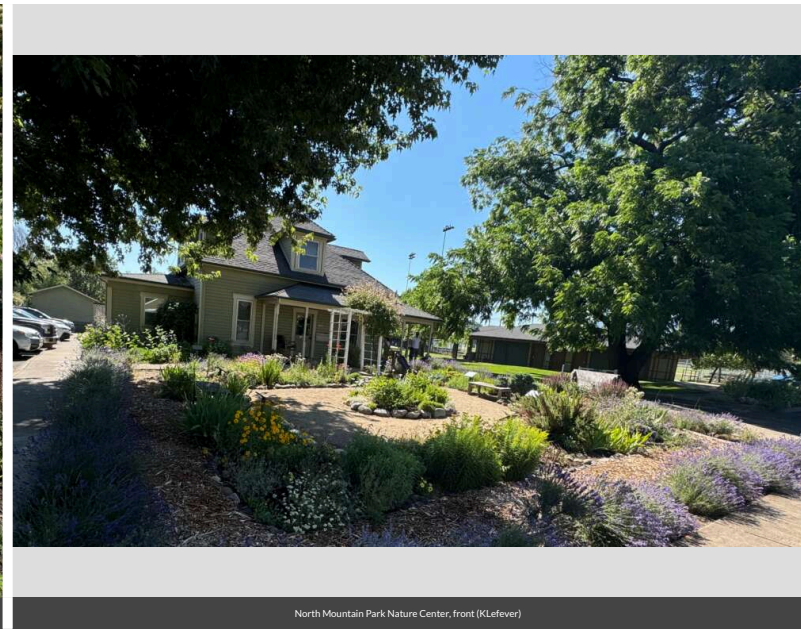
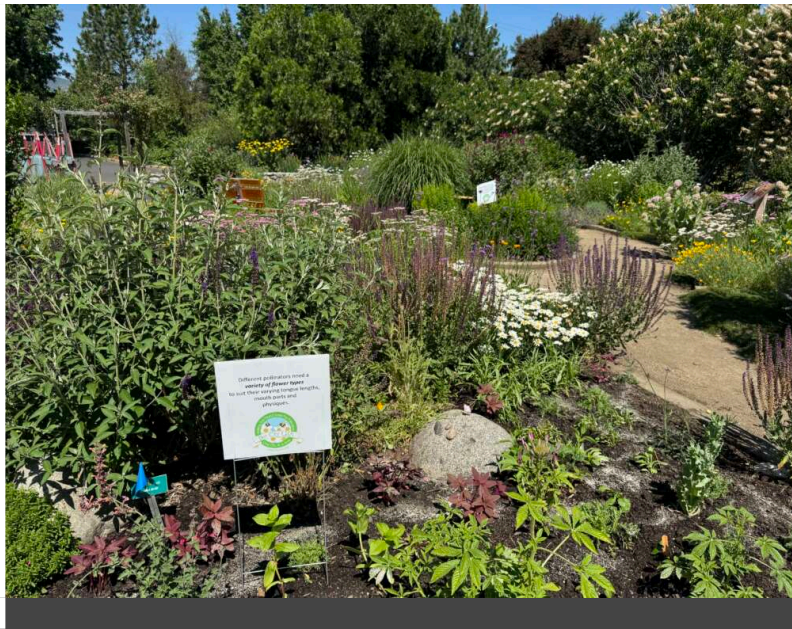
### Pollinator Habitat Creation & Enhancement

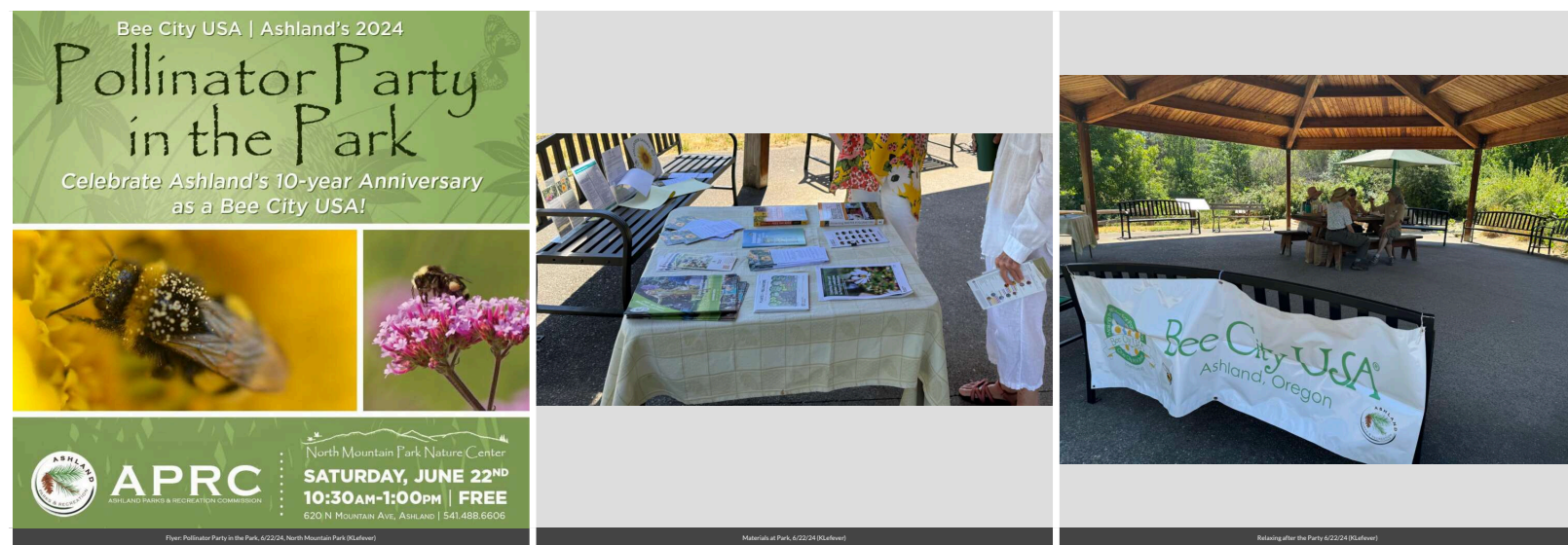
